Position Summary: Oversee the day to day operations of the Sandy Cove Marina to help guests enjoy waterfront activities and engage in safe boating practices.

Role Qualifications:

- Current First Aid certification by a recognized certifying agency (i.e. American Red Cross, YMCA, etc.)
- Current CPR certification by a recognized certifying agency (i.e. American Red Cross, YMCA, etc.)
- Outgoing, adaptable and flexible
- Ability to supervise others toward goals and outcomes
- Excellent communication, judgment and decision making abilities
- Ability to swim

Position Responsibilities:

- Greet and serve each person in a courteous and professional manner
- Perform orientations for boaters and communicate and enforce safe boating practices (including the wearing of PFD's by all boaters) to ensure the safety of all people at the waterfront.
- Respond as trained and instructed to waterfront emergencies as necessary
- Maintain neat and clean appearance of Marina by picking up litter, and properly caring for, handling and storing marina equipment and supplies
- Be aware of and adhere to all safety guidelines and practices
- Train and supervise marina crew to perform above duties as well.
- Inspect and repair boats and equipment as able, and oversee outsourcing of repairs if required
- Drive Sandy Cove pulling boats as needed, train and supervise others who drive boats.
- Perform all related necessary duties as assigned by supervisor

Reporting to this position: Program Ministry Team Members assigned, Captains

Non Essential Skills & Experience:

- Prior Lifeguard experience
- Prior experience working on boats

Physical demands of work environment: The physical demands and work environment characteristics described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential function of the job.
