CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS: \$809,225

Thanks to your financial support, we completed the transformation of Kalbach Welcome Center. Renamed The Commons, this bright, open space features more seating, expanded views of the water, and a year-round café called Uncle Wilf's.

In addition, 30 guest rooms were remodeled, including new flooring, windows, furniture upgrades, and updated bathrooms.
