# **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

# Thursday Evening Dance Program

**"Where His Light Was"** | Dance and the dancers' testimonies will be interwoven in this evening dance presentation. Dance is used to explore how God has been faithful in their lives and to share that hope and healing with those encountered.

Artist Chat - Behind the Scenes | Get to know the heart of the dance Company as Andrea facilitates an informal Q&A with Company leadership and members.

# **Friday Morning**

"How Dance Intersects with Our Faith!" | Join us for a time of sharing from Encountered Heart about the intersection of faith and dance, as well as time to explore and experience how YOU can use dance as a form of worship, too.

#### Guest Join in Worship!

You will enjoy trying basic dance movements and use them in the context of worship. This session is for everyone – dancers, non-dancers, all fitness levels!

**Simple Movement** | Sometimes it is hard to know where to start when it comes to dancing! We can feel awkward and weird if we have never used our bodies in this way before. This portion of our time will be about learning a variety of simple movements that can stretch and challenge our bodies and make us feel more comfortable with movement.

**Worship & Prayer** | This time will be dedicated to learning how to apply the simple movement that we have learned in a worshipful way. The Bible talks about a variety of positions in which people worship and pray: standing, kneeling, prostrate, with their hands raised, shouting, etc. We will get to explore this idea with our own movement!

**Holy Stretch** - The idea behind a "holy stretch" is a quieting of our bodies and minds to listen to the Holy Spirit. We will go through a series of simple stretches and postures that focus our hearts and minds on worship, prayer, and communion with the Lord.

# GUEST CHECK-IN INSTRUCTIONS(\*)

#### Overnight Guests:

Your special Check-in will be at the Front Desk of the Chesapeake Lodge (1st Floor). Approximately one mile up on Sandy Cove Road, turn left at the fork in the road following the signs to "Overnight Guest Check-in" parking in these lots.

Your special Check-in will be at the Kalbach Welcome Center (3rd Floor) of the Lodge. Approximately one mile up on Sandy Cove Road, turn right into the "Day Use Parking" area. Drop off passengers by following the signed arrows for "Day Event Check-in" (turning right at the fork in the road) and follow to the burgundy awning.

# OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES

Chair Massages | Sign-up at Milburn, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor | Cost \$16.00

A portable chair designed for comfort and support is used as massage therapists administer a 15-minute, fully-clothed, stress-relieving massage designed to enhance circulation, reduce muscle tension and leave you feeling relaxed and refreshed. Creative Tables – New to Girls Night Out & Day Off are tables located on the 3rd Floor where you can gather with friends and meet new sisters. There will be small puzzles you may start and/or complete, and inspirational Coloring Pages. A place to sit, chat, "puzzle," color and enjoy.
